PRELIMINARY ADVICE RECEIVED FOR MCINTOSH HERITAGE CLEARANCE SURVEY

Lamboo Resources Limited ("Lamboo") is pleased to announce it is in receipt of preliminary advice from the Heritage Clearance Survey conducted from the 22nd April 2015 through to the 26th April 2015. The Heritage Survey was conducted with members of Lamboo staff, representatives from the Traditional Owner group, the Marlargowem, along with representatives from Environmental, Heritage and Social Impact Services ("EHSIS").

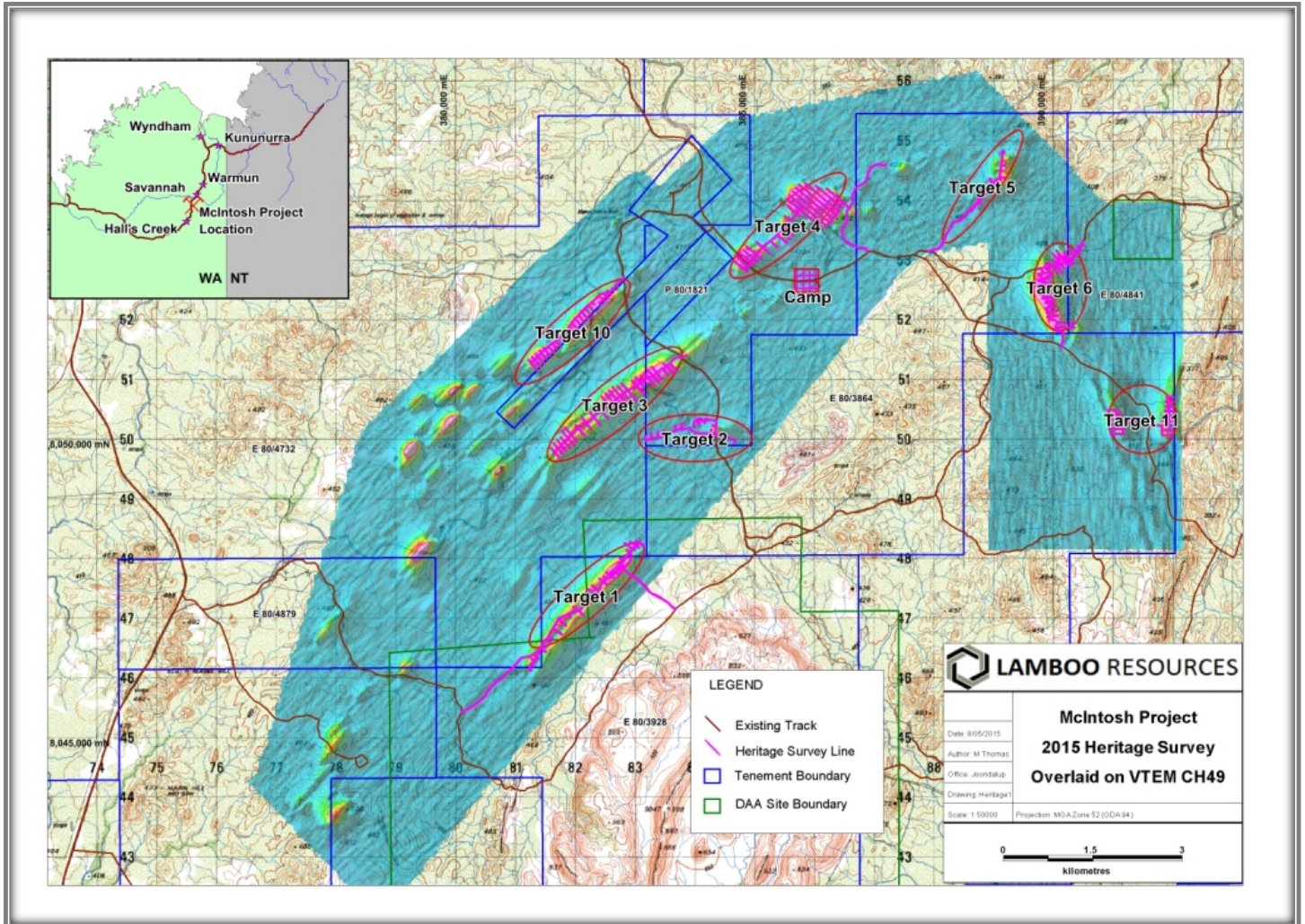


Figure 1: Heritage Clearance Survey completed 22nd - 26th April 2015.

The Heritage Survey covered Target areas 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 10, 11 along with the campsite (Figure 1), no sites of significance were identified during the survey. The final Heritage Survey report is expected in due course allowing for commencement of drilling activities. A Drilling contractor has now been engaged with mobilisation and on-ground exploration due to commence shortly.

"This is another significant milestone for the company, we have a great relationship with the Traditional Owners, the Marlargowem and their representative body the Kimberley Land Council ("KLC"). Lamboo will continue to work closely with the Traditional Owners of the land in which we operate and we look forward to providing opportunities for the local community as the McIntosh Project progresses towards production" commented Lamboo's Head of Operations, Tony Cormack.
